Written and composed by Krystin Lennox & Keith Getty in 2002, the two verses in this modern hymn present listeners with a unified dichotomy: Jesus is the Shepherd on one hand; he is the Lamb on the other. He is at one with God, and also living among his flock. The chorus that follows each verse reminds listeners that Heaven's voices sing; while singers can be placed among the throng through the unifying power attributed to Jesus in both verses.

It is by intention a song of praise to God. To this end, it has been technically engineered to uplift in two ways. Firstly, the direction 'Majestically' sets a tempo designed to slow the music down enough to allow some pause for thought for the words being sung. Secondly, though set in the major key of A, the tune is laced with counter-point chords of the corresponding minor key, F#m, raising and lowering the sung mood according to the lyrical phrase being delivered.
